At the end of this week's Parsha, the Torah shares the incident of the battle fought between משה and the sinister giant, עוג. The Posuk relates that as עוג is coming out to wage war against the Jewish people, Hashem reassures שנה that everything will be ok with the words "אַל־תִּיָרָא אֹתוֹ כִּי בְיָדְךָ נָתַתִּי אֹתוֹ don't be afraid, I will deliver him into your hands." The clear implication is that **משה** was worried that this fight might not go in his favor. But why not? The man who had performed countless miracles with the help of Hashem, defeated world empires, split seas, and just defeated a giant just as powerful as עוג אין העוג the man should be afraid?!

So Rashi explains, yes. משה was concerned. Because איש was different. And this difference was not bigger muscles, sophisticated weapons, or a more sound military strategy. עוג had a merit on his side. Because it was עוג who informed עוג that עוג was captured all those years earlier. This led to אברהם going into battle to spare his family. Perhaps this זכות would be repaid right now. So Hashem tells משה "don't worry, the battle is yours for the taking."

The שפתי חכמים makes an astonishing point. עוג did not exactly have altruistic motives in that episode! Rashi relates on the spot that was anticipating אברהם would charge into battle, would undoubtedly die, paving the way for עוג to marry ושרה שול lt was essentially murder by proxy! How could משה possibly be concerned he had any merits from this event?! Answers, the שפתים, it doesn't matter. Whatever the intent, a חסד is a חסד. And it deserves reward. חסד.

Against this backdrop, I speak for all our staff when I say it is so satisfying to work with such a sterling group of campers. These boys are not performing עוג style **חסד**. We are witnessing all day genuine, caring, sincere acts of kindness between Hashem's children. It is gratifying, rewarding, and empowering to see! Keep up the great work Eeshay, looking forward to week three!
